History of the Blues in Song

FAIRFIELD, OH – Singer/songwriter **Lisa Biales** brings to life a ***History of the Blues*** in song. She performs her own music and the works of Memphis Minnie, Sippie Wallace, and Mississippi John Hurt at the **Fairfield Community Arts Center** Friday, October 28 at 8:00 pm as part of the popular Wine, Women & Song series. Lisa also gives examples of the influence that Blues music has had on artists such as Bonnie Raitt and Patsy Cline. Biales grew up in a musical family and started performing at the age of thirteen. Singing from the heart and writing playful music about the simple things in life, she weaves a down-home blues vernacular with finger style acoustic guitar to create songs that feel like they've been around forever. Dubbed the "Belle of the Blues" for her crystal clear voice and charming stage presence, Biales has released eight albums to date. *Belle of the Blues*, released in March 2014 and produced by EG Kight and Paul Hornsby, was nominated for a Blues Blast award for **"Acoustic Album of the Year."**

In 2013, Biales was backed by Ricky Nye and The Paris Blues Band, and recorded *Singing in my Soul* an up-beat early Jazz and Blues album. The album won the Cincinnati Blues Society's Best Self-Produced CD and garnered Biales a spot at the August 2014 Cincinnati Blues Fest.
