- Minutes- Reviewed minutes from May. Noticed the next show for the gallery listed Queen City but was actually Hilltop. Sherry made the motion, Pat 2nd the motion. Minutes were approved as corrected.
- New Business
 - Gallery
 - Hilltop's show opening is on June 20th from 6-8pm.
 - There is a wedding in the gallery, so the exhibit will stay up longer, in order to add style for the event.
 - Theatre Events
