 - Kim Hunker photography exhibit opened on Friday, February 27th. She sold 12 of her pieces on the opening night. This worked well as it was opening night of the Fairfield Footlighters production of Love Letters, and the audience wandered through the gallery.

 - Miami Valley Ballet's spring show is scheduled for the weekend of April 17th with two performances: La Boutique Fantasque and Breaking Boundaries.
 - Rental client on April 25th is Emerald Entertainment's production of "A Mother's Plea"
 - Since Steven Knight's April 24th show is already sold out, Heidi is contacting him to see about a 2nd show that weekend (possibly April 26th).
