

CITY OF FAIRFIELD  
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 7-2015

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on April 13, 2015. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 27-15 Agreement with Priority Dispatch of Salt Lake City, Utah for software, quality control support, and 24 hours of training for dispatchers and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 28-15 Contract with Scherzinger Drilling of Miamitown for the 2015 Burns Road Stabilization Repair Project and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 29-15 Contract with Fuller Ford, Inc. for the purchase of four (4) vehicles for Police, Court and Public Works Departments and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 30-15 Salaries for certain exempt and salaried employees of the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to repeal Ordinance No. 32-14 and all amendments thereto and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 31-15 Reconcile accounts
- Ord. 32-15 Appropriation Ordinance - Contractual Appropriations - \$50,545 for Emergency Medical Dispatcher Program; \$75,513 for funding of third year of three-year contract with T.R. Gear Landscaping; \$70,000 for 2015 Burns Road Stabilization Repair Project; \$116,238 for purchase of vehicles for Police, Court and Public Works Departments.
- Ord. 33-15 Appropriation Ordinance - Non-Contractual Appropriations - \$17,000 for hardware maintenance agreement with CDW-G; \$44,850 for 2015 Parking Lot Maintenance Program; \$49,916 for purchase of Chevrolet Tahoe 4x4 for Fire Department; \$26,026 for purchase of 2015 Chevrolet Equinox for Sewer Division; \$17,000 for purchase of chemicals to remove roots from public sewer mains; \$6,000 for replacement of Thickened Sludge Flow Meter and Aeration System Flow Meter; \$10,000 for purchase of replacement manhole castings.
- Res. 2-15 Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Cooperative Purchasing Program and declaring an emergency.
- Res. 3-15 Resolution to approve 2015-2019 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget.
