

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 8-2015

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on April 27, 2015. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 34-15 Encroachment agreement with RTFD, LLC dba Skyline to temporarily use a portion of an existing surplus right-of-way for a parking lot and dumpster location.
- Ord. 35-15 Contract with Precision Concrete Cutting for the 2015 Sidewalk Repair Program.
- Ord. 36-15 Contract with Horton Emergency Vehicles for the purchase of a Medium Duty Modular Ambulance and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 37-15 Contract with Adleta Construction for the 2015 Street Repair Program.
- Ord. 38-15 Contract with Rush Truck Centers for the purchase of two (2) single axle dump trucks for the Public Works Department and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 39-15 Contract with Henderson Truck Equipment – Ohio for the outfitting of two (2) single axle dump trucks for the Public Works Department and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 40-15 Contract with A&A Safety, Inc. of Cincinnati, Ohio for the 2015 Pavement Marking Application Program.
- Ord. 41-15 One (1) year contract with Carmeuse North America for the purchase of lime for use in the Water Division and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 42-15 Appropriation Ordinance - Contractual Appropriations - \$236,785 for the purchase of a Medium Duty Modular Ambulance; \$375,000 for the 2015 Asphalt Paving and Resurfacing Project; \$163,760 for the purchase of two (2) single axle dump trucks for use in the Public Works Department; \$113,680 for outfitting of two (2) single axle dump trucks for use in the Public Works Department; \$90,000 for the 2015 Pavement Marking Application Program.
- Ord. 43-15 Appropriation Ordinance - Non-Contractual Appropriations - \$9,950 for purchase of materials for manhole rehabilitation; \$5,000 for Traffic Signal System Assistance; \$10,000 for various NPDES Phase II storm water system expenses; \$10,000 for miscellaneous traffic signal upgrades and spare parts; \$17,700 for support of equipment and software; \$30,000 for crack sealing by J&A Construction, Inc.; \$27,500 for drainage improvements at 6100 block of Pleasant Avenue; \$7,130 for equipment and installation of overhead door; \$31,345 for purchase of 2014 trailer mounted leaf vacuum machine; \$8,970 for purchase of tandem axle tilt deck trailer; \$34,568 for Library HVAC upgrades; \$48,000 for personal protective equipment for Fire Department; \$29,000 for structural firefighting helmets for Fire Department.
- Res. 4-15 Support of Issue #3 the 0.75-mil Lane Public Library Renewal Levy.
- Res. 5-15 Objection to the renewal of the liquor permit for Swright Productions, LLC dba Blue Note Lighthouse Café aka Wise Guys Bar and Grill and declaring an emergency.
