

CITY OF FAIRFIELD  
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 12-2014

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on July 14, 2014. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 66-14                    Ordinance for Community Reinvestment Area Agreement and a Community Reinvestment Area Compensation Agreement, which will provide property tax incentives for Machintek Corporation and 410 Properties, Ltd. for the construction of an addition to an office and manufacturing facility on Port Union Road and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 67-14                    Ordinance for a contract with Mount Pleasant Blacktopping for the purchase of asphalt materials and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 68-14                    Ordinance for a contract with R. A. Miller Construction Co., Inc. to replace curb ramps in the Redwood, Fenwick and Walter Vicinity and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 69-14                    Ordinance for a contract with Henderson Truck Equipment to outfit a 2015 Single Axle Dump Truck Unit #37.
- Ord. 70-14                    Ordinance for a contract with R. A. Miller Construction Co., Inc. to replace existing drywells in the Vinnedge, Walter and Van Cleves Vicinity and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 71-14                    Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109-13 entitled "An Ordinance to make estimated appropriations for the expenses and other expenditures of the City of Fairfield, Ohio, during a period beginning January 1, 2014, and ending December 31, 2014."
- Res. 9-14                    Resolution adopting the tax budget of the City of Fairfield, Ohio, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and submitting the same to the Butler County Auditor and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 72-14                    Ordinance for an agreement with CDW-G for the purchase of replacement computer workstations and related equipment for city users.
- Ord. 73-14                    Ordinance for an agreement with Digital Visions for the replacement, additions and upgrades to the City's security camera network and declaring an emergency
- Ord. 74-14                    Appropriation Ordinance- Contractual Appropriations – \$45,000 for curb ramp replacement, \$84,231 to outfit a 2015 dump truck for Public Works, \$75,000 to replace drywells, \$66,000 for computer workstations and related equipment, \$224,400 for replacement, additions and upgrades to the City's security camera network, \$55,000 for asphalt restoration from water system repairs.
- Ord. 75-14                    Appropriation Ordinance - Non-Contractual Appropriations - \$49,533 for window replacement and improvements at Elisha Morgan Mansion, \$48,555 for window and metal cladding replacement at Fire Headquarters, \$27,000 for various repairs at the Municipal and Municipal Annex Buildings, \$24,000 for overlay/sealing/stripping of parking lots and tennis courts for the Parks Department, \$23,837.03 to replace pistols for the Police Department, \$20,000 for software for the City website and building permit software for the Development Services Department, \$16,000 for drainage improvements at various locations, \$25,000 for seasonal and special event banners for the Town Center and Gilmore Rd., \$14,650 for a portable changeable message sign, \$11,680 for purchase and fabrication of an automatic weed sprayer for the Street Division, \$10,000 for fire hose and related equipment, \$5,000 for an additional time clock for North Trace Golf and Aquatic Center, \$2,000 for a replacement operations server for Police records and Dispatch, \$12,400 for manhole casting adjustments, \$10,000 for painting the Broadview Pump Station roof structure, \$7,100 for concrete curb/cart path repairs at Fairfield Greens Golf Course/South Trace, \$17,800 for one top dresser unit and one turf roller for the Golf Maintenance Division.
