

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 7-2012

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on April 9, 2012. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 31-12 Ordinance to amend Section 181.01, entitled "purpose", of Ordinance No. 166-84, the Codified Ordinances of Fairfield, Ohio, relative to the apportionment of the existing municipal income tax.
- Ord. 32-12 Contract with Southern Group, Inc. to replace existing drywells in the Lindale Subdivision.
- Ord. 33-12 Contract with Bob Ross Buick, Inc. for purchase of Chevrolet Sierra 4 x 4 3500 pickup truck (Unit #6316) for use by the Street Department.
- Ord. 34-12 Ordinance to declare an obsolete server formally used for Police Dispatch as surplus and authorize the City Manager or designee to dispose of the equipment.
- Ord. 35-12 2012 Budget Amendments: \$24,980 emergency pre-emption for traffic signals; \$15,000 miscellaneous traffic signal upgrades; \$20,000 traffic cameras for I-275 Winton/South Gilmore Corridor Project; \$24,900 erosion repair for River Road across from Bolten Water Plant; \$12,800 fencing improvements at Groh Lane; \$24,950 replacement T-12 fluorescent light bulb at Water Plant; \$2,900 concrete repairs at Water Plant; \$4,750 door at Water plant; \$3,000 electrical work at Route 4 Booster Station; \$3,350 chemical feed pump at Route 4 Booster Station; \$12,000 gate and security fencing at Groh Lane; \$18,680 replace staff vehicle unit #626; \$17,250 Wastewater Treatment Plant structure repairs at Digester #2; \$28,000 Wastewater Treatment Plant masonry repair work at Digester #2; and \$10,000 replacement/overhaul of Wastewater pump.
- Ord. 36-12 2012 Budget Amendments: \$115,000 replace existing drywells in Lindale Subdivision; \$25,903 replace pickup truck #6316 in Street Department.
- Res. 5-12 Resolution to direct the Butler County, Ohio Board of Elections to conduct an election with regard to the reapportionment of the existing Municipal Income Tax as stated in Ordinance No. 31-12 of the City of Fairfield, Ohio.
