LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 12-2010

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on July 13, 2010. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 64-10 Occupancy agreement with Bible Baptist Church to encroach on part lot 164 owned by the City of Fairfield, Ohio.
- Ord. 65-10 Contract with Michigan Police Equipment Company for the purchase of patrol rifles and related equipment for each police vehicle.
- Ord. 66-10 Agreement with ODOT for the Exit 39- South Gilmore/Winton Road Improvements referred to by ODOT as – HAM/BUT CR239 – 9.49 (PID #83469).
- Ord. 67-10 One year contract with A & A Safety for the 2010 application of Roadway Pavement Markings.
- Ord. 68-10 Contract with O’Brien & Gere Engineers for engineering services associated with water system modeling activities for the Water Division.
- Ord. 69-10 2010 Budget Amendments: \$60,000 South Gilmore/Winton Road Improvements Right of Way Acquisitions; \$18,216 raw well #8 electrical work and construction; \$23,417 Ford Explorer for Park Ranger; \$5,584 related Park Ranger vehicle equipment; and \$30,000 2010 Business District Program.
- Ord. 70-10 2010 Budget Amendments: \$28,000 sanitary lateral replacement at Municipal Building; \$38,662 Northern Route 4 Landscaping Project; \$90,000 roadway pavement markings; \$70,320 patrol rifles and related equipment; \$37,270 engineering for water system modeling.
- Res. 5-10 Resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute the Final Legislative Agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the North Route 4 Landscaping Project.
- Res. 6-10 Resolution adopting the tax budget of the City of Fairfield, Ohio for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2011 and submitting same to the Butler County Auditor.
