

CITY OF FAIRFIELD
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 12-2012

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on July 9, 2012. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 66-12 Contract with Capital Electric Line Builders for Traffic Signal Vehicle Detection Installation.
- Ord. 67-12 Contract with Miller Pipeline Corporation for the 2012 lining of storm sewers.
- Ord. 68-12 Contract with Ohio Heavy Equipment Leasing, LLC dba Loveland Excavating for the Mackview Street drainage improvement project.
- Ord. 69-12 Contract with Barrett Paving Materials, Inc. for the River Road Improvements Project.
- Ord. 70-12 Contract with Hirlinger Chevrolet for the purchase of a utility vehicle for use by the Fire Department.
- Ord. 71-12 Declare twelve (12) city vehicles as surplus and authorize the City Manager to sell the vehicles on GovDeals.com
- Ord. 72-12 Contract with PCS Technologies for SCADA System Integration Services at the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- Ord. 73-12 Contract with Miller Pipeline Corp. for inversion re-lining of sanitary sewer lines.
- Ord. 74-12 Community Reinvestment Area Agreement, a Community Reinvestment Area Compensation Agreement and a Sanitary Sewer Administrative Fee Rebate Agreement, related to an expansion project for Koch Foods of Cincinnati LLC.
- Ord. 75-12 Contract with MobileTEK for the purchase of mobile data terminals for Police cruisers.
- Ord. 76-12 2012 Budget Amendments (Contractual): \$55,000 Traffic Signal Vehicle Detection Installation; \$50,000 2012 Storm Sewer Lining; \$48,000 replacement of drywells on Mackview Street; \$1,615,000 River Road Improvements; \$139,500 SCADA System Integration Services; \$135,000 inversion re-lining of sanitary sewer lines; \$45,000 mobile data terminals for Police cruisers; \$46,000 utility vehicle for use by the Fire Department.
- Ord. 77-12 2012 Budget Amendments (Non-contractual): \$9,800 manhole rehabilitation materials, \$5,000 Police Department Explorer's Post expenses, \$15,396 Public Works Facilities Maintenance Repairs, \$7,000 Fairfield Greens/South Trace and Gilbert Farms Park parking lot renovations, \$9,200 Community Arts Center upgrades and maintenance.
- Res. 7-12 Resolution to approve the tax budget of the City of Fairfield, Ohio, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2013 and submit the same to the Butler County Auditor.
