Motorists are advised that there will be lane restrictions on Route 4 (Dixie Highway) between Holden Boulevard / South Gilmore Road and Camelot Drive (across from Jungle Jim's) beginning on Sunday, February 21, 2016 between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., weather permitting. Work is anticipated to continue for several weeks.

This is for work being performed by contractors working for Duke Energy. Work will consist of installation of a new gas main in the southbound lanes of Route 4. Additional work will also be performed by contractors working for Cincinnati Bell during this same time period in the vicinity of the intersection of Holden Boulevard / South Gilmore Road and Route 4 (Dixie Highway).

During the work periods, work zone signage will be posted and flaggers will be used when necessary. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained except for brief periods when flaggers will direct traffic within a single lane. Motorists are advised that some delay should be expected during these times.
