Board of Building Appeals (4 year term of office)	Three (3) positions available. Applicants must be from one of the following trades: Building Contractor; Master Plumber; Heating Engineer. Residents appointed will serve until 3/31/2014.
Board of Zoning Appeals (5 year term of office)	One (1) position available. Residents appointed will serve until 3/31/2015.
Civil Service Commission (3 year term of office)	One (1) position available. Resident appointed will serve until 3/31/2013. Three members serve on this Commission and according to the Charter, not more than two members shall be registered to vote in a primary election of the same political party. Currently the Board has two Republican members and cannot have a third.
Cultural Arts Advisory Commission (3 year term of office)	Three (3) positions available. Resident appointed will serve until 3/31/2013.
Environmental Commission (3 year term of office)	Four (4) positions available. Three (3) residents appointed will serve until 3/31/2013; One (1) resident appointed to fill position with term expiring 3/31/2011.
Fair Housing Board (3 year term of office)	Three (3) positions available. Residents appointed will serve until 3/31/2013.

Parks & Recreation Board (3 year term of office)	Two (2) positions available – the first ward seat and the fourth ward seat. Residents appointed will serve until 3/31/2013.
