City of Fairfield Announces New Assistant City Manager

FAIRFIELD, Ohio – The City of Fairfield has named Laura Murphy as new Assistant City Manager.

Murphy, who has been serving as Butler County’s Human Resources Director since September of 2017, joins Fairfield with wide a breadth of experience in the legal profession and holds a Juris Doctorate Degree from the University of Dayton School of Law, as well as a Bachelor of Arts in Public Justice. She is a member of CORSA’s Best Practices Personnel Policy steering committee and is a volunteer choreographer to various community theater groups in the Greater Cincinnati area.

City Manager, Scott Timmer, worked with Murphy during his brief tenure with Butler County in 2021. He states, “While at the County, I had the opportunity to work with a tremendous team of department heads. In that time, Laura and I worked closely on a variety of tasks, while developing a strong, mutual respect for each other. Additionally, we developed a rapport that allowed us to achieve common goals. When I arrived back at the City of Fairfield, I met with our senior staff to determine our needs at the executive level, and then we advertised for the Assistant City Manager position with that skillset in mind. Ms. Murphy brings a wealth of experience in Labor Management, among other valuable skills, to our high-performing team, and we are excited to get her onboarded so that we can continue to impactfully serve the City.”

Murphy is expected to begin Assistant City Manager duties with the City of Fairfield on June 6th.
