**Announcement –
Night-time Utility Work on Route 4**

Fairfield, OH –

Motorists are advised that night-time paving work will begin Tuesday 10/25/2022 on Route 4 in Fairfield. Multiple lanes and locations along Route 4 will be affected between Bypass 4 and Seward Road. This work will take place between 9:00 PM and 4:00 AM each night and will involve periodic 15-minute road closures. This work will continue each night through Friday night, 10/28/2022. Traffic delays are likely. Please avoid these areas if possible, or use caution while traveling in these areas and pay close attention to all construction warnings.

This work is part of an ongoing utility project to improve public water system assets in Fairfield, Ohio.
