DSG-Canusa establishing operations in City of Fairfield

FAIRFIELD, Ohio – July 31, 2023 – The City of Fairfield announces that DSG-Canusa, a division of Mattr US Inc., is expanding its manufacturing and distribution services by establishing operations at Building V of Fairfield Commerce Park. This expansion project was a collaborative effort between Fairfield, the State of Ohio, and JobsOhio to keep the company growing in Southwest Ohio.

“DSG-Canusa is a strong addition to our robust industrial business mix,” said Fairfield Mayor Mitch Rhodus, “We are excited to see the creation of new manufacturing jobs within our community. It is our goal to be a business-friendly city and this exciting announcement helps to validate those efforts.”

“Strategically relocating our DSG-Canusa production footprint to Ohio positions us closer to our North American supplier and customer base, simplifying and enhancing our operations,” said Frank Cistrone, President of Mattr’s Connection Technologies segment, “This new site brings more jobs to Fairfield, while also creating a pathway for our business to safely and efficiently expand capacity to meet the long-term demand for our high-value products.”

DSG-Canusa is a manufacturer of integrated heat-shrink & cold-shrink tubing for industrial applications serving a diverse set of markets, including automotive, electrical and utility, renewables, communications, aerospace and defense and transportation. Through its more than 50 years of operation, DSG-Canusa has demonstrated the innovation to evolve capabilities and incorporate emerging fields and applications into its services.

Fairfield’s proximity to transportation infrastructure and its innovative approach to connecting local businesses to talent, which includes the annual Fairfield Career Fest at Fairfield High School, provides companies with the market and talent access necessary to expand operations.

DSG-Canusa will occupy the fifth and final building in Fairfield Commerce Park, a highly-successful Class A industrial park located on Seward Road. The park contains 1.6 million square feet of modern industrial space that is fully leased to a mix of manufacturing and distribution firms.

Assistance provided by the State of Ohio, JobsOhio and City of Fairfield directly supports DSG-Canusa’s commitment to creating 48 new jobs over the next three years. The City is supporting the company through a performance-based property tax abatement and the State of Ohio has

approved a tax credit for the project. JobsOhio plans to provide assistance, which will be made public once the final agreement is executed.
