South Gilmore Road to be Closed for 30 Days for Road Work beginning Monday, June 3rd

Fairfield, OH – Motorists are advised that South Gilmore Road will be closed between Mack Road and Resor Road beginning Monday, June 3, 2024, weather permitting.

The closure is for work being performed for the City of Fairfield by the John R. Jurgensen Company to do storm sewer work. This is the first part of a project to make roadway improvements between Mack Road and Resor Road and is expected to take approximately 30 days. This project to widen South Gilmore Road to five lanes will continue through the summer and fall. After this initial road closure, the rest of the project will be performed while maintaining two way traffic through the construction zone.

A detour route will be posted guiding traffic from Mack Road to Winton Road to Resor Road. Flraig Drive (just north of Mack Road) will remain open to traffic.

Prior to the closure, portable electronic message boards will be posted notifying the public of the upcoming change to traffic patterns.

The project to improve this section of South Gilmore Road has been in development for several years. The City of Fairfield received a federal grant for nearly \$2.5M through the Ohio Kentucky Indiana Regional Council of Governments to help fund this \$4.5M project.
