**Seward & Tylersville intersection to be closed for 12 weeks
for road work beginning Monday, August 19, 2024.**

Fairfield, OH – Motorists are advised that the intersection of Seward Road and Tylersville Road will be closed beginning Monday, August 19, 2024, weather permitting.

The closure is for work being performed for the City of Fairfield by the Rack and Ballauer Excavating Company to remove the existing traffic signal and construct a modern roundabout at this intersection to improve capacity and safety. Roundabouts are a proven safety countermeasure that reduces fatal and injury crashes by 78% when compared to traffic signals. Roundabouts are also efficient at keeping traffic moving and will reduce congestion and delays.

Some water system improvements will also be made with this project and residents will be notified of any scheduled disruptions to service.

A detour route will be posted guiding traffic from Hamilton Mason Road to State Route 4 Bypass to Symmes Road. The detour map is posted on the City's website along with project information at www.fairfield-city.org.

Portable electronic message boards will be posted one week ahead of the closure notifying the public of the upcoming change to traffic patterns.

The project to improve this intersection has been in development for several years. The City of Fairfield is funding this project with assistance from State funding through the Butler County Transportation Improvement District, some private funding from the adjacent commercial developer, and Fairfield Township.
