**Ross Road to be closed for 4 Weeks for Road Work
beginning Monday, September 9th**

Fairfield, OH – Motorists are advised that the intersection of Ross Road and Chapel Hill Drive will be closed beginning Monday, September 9, 2024, for four weeks, weather permitting.

The closure is for work being performed for the City of Fairfield by Adleta Construction to add curb, sidewalk, and storm sewer to the west side of Ross Road between Cheryl Drive and Cherryhill Drive. The proposed curb will improve roadway safety while the addition of a sidewalk will fill in a significant gap in pedestrian connectivity in the City. The sidewalk need was identified in the City's comprehensive connectivity plan "Fairfield Connects" which was developed a few years ago and is available on the City's website along with a detour route at www.fairfield-city.org.

The detour route will be posted guiding traffic from Mack Road to Boymel Drive to Route 4. Portable electronic message boards will be posted one week ahead of the closure notifying the public of the upcoming change to traffic patterns.

The City of Fairfield is funding this project with assistance from County funding through the American Rescue Plan Act.
