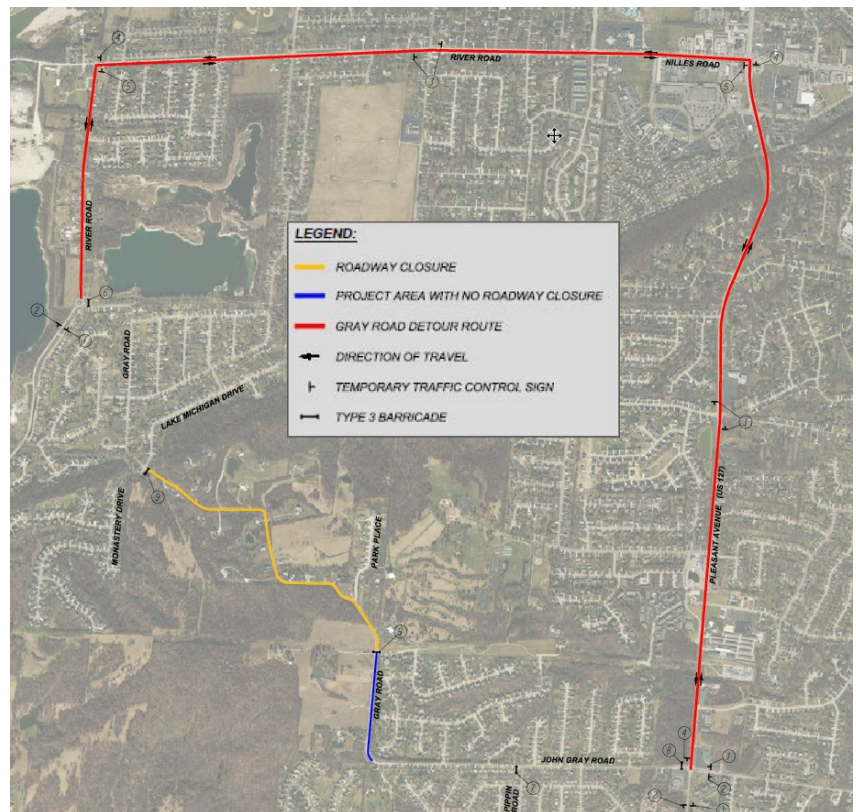


FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – Monday, September 30, 2024

Gray Road to be closed for 90 days between Lake Michigan Drive and West Augusta Boulevard starting on October 7, 2024, for water line replacement work.

Motorists are advised that Gray Road will be closed for 90 days starting on Monday, October 7, 2024, between Lake Michigan Drive and West Augusta Boulevard. This closure is necessary while water line replacement work is performed for the City of Fairfield by Rack & Ballauer Excavating Co. Inc. This water system improvement project will replace around 7,000 feet of old and failing cast iron water main under Gray Road. This project will significantly improve water system reliability for utility customers in this area, including all residents in the Monastery subdivision.

Through traffic will be prohibited in this area during the road closure. Detour route signage will be posted guiding traffic to Pleasant Avenue (US 127) during the closure. Portable electronic message boards will be posted one week prior to the closure notifying the public of the upcoming traffic pattern changes.
