## **Seward Road Closure & Traffic Detour**

**Fairfield, OH** – Motorists are advised that beginning Monday, October 6, road improvements on Seward Road south of Norfolk Southern's railroad tracks to north of the Mill Creek will require the road to be closed to through traffic. The closure is located between Union Centre Boulevard/Symmes Road and Tylersville Road. The closure will last for approximately 45 days, weather permitting. This closure is needed to realign the curvature of the road north of the bridge over the Mill Creek and to reprofile the roadway approaching the railroad tracks from both the north and the south. Work will be performed by Barrett Paving Materials, Inc.

During the road closure, access to the trailhead parking lot will not be permitted. The trail will remain open and can be accessed at Gilmore Ponds Metropark using one of their two entrances/parking lots; North Gilmore Road, or Symmes Road at Bilstein Boulevard

Prior to the closure, portable electronic message boards will be posted notifying the public of the upcoming changes to traffic patterns. During the closure a detour will be posted directing traffic around the construction site via Symmes Road to Bypass 4 to Tylersville Road.
