Fire Lt. Tom Wagner earns Fire Officer credential

Fairfield, OH – Fire Lt. Tom Wagner recently earned designation as a Fire Officer (FO) from The Center for Public Safety Excellence. He is one of only 373 Fire Officer designees worldwide.

The Center for Public Safety Excellence is a non-profit corporation. It provides a variety of resources for fire and emergency professionals to continuously improve.

The FO program is voluntary and recognizes individuals who demonstrate excellence in seven areas: experience, education, professional development, professional contributions, association membership, community involvement, and technical competence. The Commission on Professional Credentialing (CPC) awards the designation.

Lt. Wagner became a Firefighter with the City of Fairfield's Fire Department in 1993. He was appointed Station Supervisor in 2003 and promoted to Lieutenant in 2007.

He has a Master's in Public Safety Administration from Lewis University. He is licensed by the Ohio Department of Public Safety as a Firefighter II, Fire Instructor, Fire Safety Inspector, and Paramedic.
