Leaf Collection to begin Monday, Nov. 6

Fairfield, OH - Free leaf collection will be provided in residential areas starting Monday, Nov. 6, according to the schedule listed below.

Residents are asked to place the leaves between the curb and sidewalk, or in areas without a curb, adjacent to the street. Leaves should not be raked into the street, as gutters and storm sewers can become blocked and cause localized flooding during moderate to heavy rainfall.

Also, residents are asked to please not park in front of or near the piles between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. because the trucks cannot reach them and those piles will be left until the next scheduled collection week. Grass clippings, sticks, limbs or brush should not be placed in with leaves. These can clog and damage equipment and injure workers.

Residents who have a small amount of leaves, or who do not wish to participate, may find it more convenient to bag leaves and place them curbside for pick-up on the regular trash collection day.

Leaves will be collected on the following tentative schedule:

STREETS <u>WEST</u> OF PLEASANT AVENUE:	November 6 thru November 10 November 27 thru December 1 December 18 thru December 22
STREETS <u>BETWEEN</u> PLEASANT AVENUE AND WINTON ROAD:	November 13 thru November 17 December 4 thru December 8 December 25 thru December 29
STREETS <u>EAST</u> OF WINTON ROAD:	November 20 thru November 24 December 11 thru December 15 January 1 thru January 5
