Sisters, Songwriters, Storytellers

FAIRFIELD, OH – Nashville recording artists **Adelee & Gentry** will perform at the **Fairfield Community Arts Center** (FCAC) **Friday, March 2 at 8 p.m.** as part of the popular Wine, Women & Song series. Dayton, Ohio natives, this sister duo will perform several of their original songs, while telling the stories behind them, and mix in some well-known covers that they have put their own unique spin on to create a fun, intimate show for all ages.

Enjoy a cabaret setting for the concert with complimentary light hors d'oeuvres and cash bar starting at 7 p.m. Tickets are \$20 for café seating and \$15 for stadium seating. Starting their music career at the ages of 15 and 13, they now, at 24 and 22, have a polished folk-pop sound that is grounded by a rootsy base, but elevated by the self-taught sisters' uniquely captivating style of two-part harmony. They have performed with the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra, opened for Air Supply and Jayna Kramer, and have played multiple times at the famous Bluebird Cafe, Hard Rock Café, and Puckett's Grocery in Nashville, TN. They have spent the last five years playing at colleges, festivals, and Performing Arts venues across the country. Adelee & Gentry have released two albums; "Nice To Meet You..." and "Waiting For Christmas," and a single called "The Color Song," which gained recognition by Billboard 615 Spotlight alongside Gavin DeGraw and Rihanna.
