Symmes Road closure, detour starts November 16

Fairfield, OH – Beginning Friday, November 16, maintenance by CSX Transportation on Symmes Road east of Route 4 (between Industry Drive and Tedia Way) will require the road to be closed to through traffic.

The closure will be at the railroad tracks for approximately five days. The road will remain closed through Wednesday, November 21, weather permitting.

This closure is needed to perform maintenance to the existing rail and replace the concrete panel system between the rails and the roadway.

Portable electronic message boards are posted communicating the upcoming changes to traffic patterns. During the closure, a detour will be posted directing traffic around the construction site from Bilstein Boulevard / Holden Boulevard to Route 4 (Dixie Highway) to Hicks Boulevard.
