## **Brush and limb pickup is April through October**

**Fairfield, OH** - The City's Public Works Department is again providing a call-in brush and limb pickup program to residents from April through October. Residents who wish to have brush and limbs picked up can arrange to do so by:

1. Calling 513-867-4200 at least one week in advance of the scheduled pickup area; or
2. Emailing [public\\_works@fairfieldoh.gov](mailto:public_works@fairfieldoh.gov)

The three pickup areas will be the same as those used for the City's leaf pickup program. Brush and limb pickups will be scheduled starting the first Monday of each month as follows:

- The **first** week of each month – areas west of Pleasant Avenue (U.S. 127)
  - started the week of April 1 and ends the week of Oct. 7
- The **second** week of each month – areas between Pleasant Avenue and Winton Road
  - starting the week of April 8 and ending the week of Oct. 14
- The **third** week of each month – areas east of Winton Road
  - starting the week of April 15 and ending the week of Oct. 21

Brush and limbs may also be dropped off on the second Saturday of each month all year at the end of Groh Lane. Crews from the City's Parks and Recreation Department will accept drop-offs from 8 a.m. until noon on these Saturdays.

Operation Dump Truck is another program that the City operates that residents can use for larger limbs in addition to brush. This program provides residents a dumpster box or dump truck at their property to be loaded by the property owner and disposed of by the City.
