Seward Road waterline work to start Monday, Aug. 19

Fairfield, OH – On Monday, Aug. 19, at 8 a.m., scheduled waterline replacement work will begin on Seward Road between Symmes Road and Port Union Road.

Two-way traffic will be maintained throughout the duration of the project, but delays can be expected. Anticipated project completion date is mid December 2019.

The work will be performed by Smithcorp, Inc., under contract with the City. The City suggests the use of Bypass 4 as an alternate route during the project.

Prior to the start of the work, portable electronic message boards will be posted notifying the public of the upcoming changes to traffic patterns.
