

HOW TO READ YOUR NATURAL GAS BILL

Fairfield's Energy Aggregation program aims to provide stable, fixed-rate plans to protect residents from volatile energy market fluctuations. There are no enrollment, termination, or additional fees associated with the program. The City of Fairfield receives no compensation from the Energy Aggregation program.

Residents can choose to opt-out at no charge anytime.

Duke Energy Delivery charges are not impacted by the Energy Aggregation program. Delivery charges are determined by Duke and are unrelated to aggregation. They appear on your bill with or without the program.

Duke's Gas Cost Recovery Rate (GCR), or price to compare to energy aggregation

Your current rate is Residential Firm Transportation Service (RFT).

Price to compare: If you're considering using a different natural gas supplier, their rate would have to be **lower than \$0.6499 per CCF for you to save money**. Visit energychoice.ohio.gov to compare rates of all natural gas suppliers or contact Duke Energy for a written explanation.

Pursuant to an Order by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio in Case No. 21-903-GA-EXM, Duke Energy Ohio will implement a new gas rider, Rider SBC (Storage Balancing Charge, Sheet No. 78) effective June 1, 2025. Rider SBC will apply to all customers except those customers served under Rate IT. Rider SBC will recover the same costs of pipeline storage that were previously recovered through the Gas Cost Recovery Rider (Rider GCR) or certified supplier charges.

This month's Gas Cost Recovery (GCR) charge for customers purchasing their natural gas from Duke Energy is **\$0.6499 per CCF**, which includes a base GCR of **\$0.6499** and Ohio excise tax of **\$0.0000**.

When shopping for a natural gas supplier, it may be useful to compare supplier offers with the gas cost recovery (GCR) rate available to eligible customers, which varies monthly based on the market price of natural gas. Price represents one feature of any offer; there may be other features which you consider of value. Riders are costs the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has approved to cover investments in improving the energy infrastructure or other additional expenses.

REMINDER: Residents are NOT charged by Duke AND AEP Energy INC. You will receive ONE monthly bill from Duke Energy with NO additional fees associated with Fairfield's Energy Aggregation program.
