RASKALS (Random Acts of Simple Kindness Affecting Local Seniors) is a program that was started in West Chester Township. It matches volunteers of all ages with older adults to help with the yard work and outside chores that they cannot do themselves.

In April and November, the City of Fairfield Volunteer Program will send RASKALS volunteers to the homes of older adults (age 55 and over, or disabled) who lives within the City Limits. Volunteers will provide, free of charge, the following tasks:

Picking up sticks, washing 1st floor outside windows, raking leaves, sweeping sidewalks, trimming shrubs, weeding, and other general outside maintenance chores you may need done. **Please rank the items in order of importance from 1 to 5, with 1 being the most important. The volunteers are assigned to a client for approximately one (1) hour. This allows them to move on to the next client.**
